

## Biography



Peter Shien-Kuei Liaw was born in 1965. He received the Ph.D. degree from National Chiao-Tung University, Taiwan, in 1988, 1993, and 1999, respectively. In 1993, he joined the Telecommunication Laboratories, Ministry of Transportation and Communications, Taiwan. Since then, he has been working on fiber optics communication and fiber based devices. In 1996, he was a visiting researcher at Bellcore (now Telcordia), Red Bank, NJ. He joined the department of Electronics Engineering, National Taiwan university of Science and Technology as an assistant professor since August 2000. He was promoted to be a full professor since Feb 2008. He is now also acts as Director of Optoelectronics Research Center, National Taiwan University of Science and Technology, Taiwan. He has authored and co-authored over 150 international journal articles and conference presentations. His research interests include optical communication, fiber devices and fiber sensing. He has also been actively contributing the technical programs of many international and domestic conferences through various roles and serves as a referee for numerous SCI journals. He is currently sabbatical leave as an academic visitor at University of Oxford in UK.
